

BELLEVUE PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH SUNNY DAY CLUB® COVID-19 ACKNOWLEDGEMENT

The Sunny Day Club is excited about resuming in-person club meetings following our hiatus related to COVID-19. The club strives to provide one volunteer (known as the buddy) for each club member. The volunteers value their time with the members each week, and they seek to provide a safe and stimulating environment for the members.

However, the COVID-19 pandemic has presented challenging issues for the club's program. For instance, the use of masks and/or social distancing are not compatible with the nature of our program, because the members' cognitive issues make it necessary to provide an environment that offers face-to-face interaction, the ability to easily hear verbal communications, and allows for close contact with their buddies and other club volunteers. Because of the need for an environment with these social interactions between volunteers and members, the club is trying to provide some degree of protection against COVID-19 exposure by requiring all club volunteers who interact with members to be fully vaccinated (including boosters) against COVID-19. Unfortunately, even with such precautions, club activities may include outside performers and other guests or visitors who may not be vaccinated.

Since masks cannot be employed, the club is insisting that all members be fully vaccinated (including boosters) against COVID-19. Even with vaccinations, however, the Sunny Day Club cannot prevent you or your loved one from becoming exposed to, contracting, or spreading COVID-19 while utilizing Sunny Day Club's services on the church premises.

While we understand that you and your loved one's personal circumstances may not accommodate these required conditions, we hope you also appreciate and understand that we require these conditions in an attempt to provide protections against COVID-19 for not only you and your loved one, but everyone participating in club activities. Because of the unique circumstances surrounding this worldwide pandemic, we are asking the caregivers on behalf of their loved ones and themselves to execute this document to acknowledge the required conditions of participation in club activities and the risk of exposure to COVID-19 from such participation.

In addition, if you or your loved one who is a member of the club fall within any of the categories below, neither should engage in Sunny Day Club events. By attending club events, you certify that you or your loved one do not fall into any of the following categories:

1. Individuals who currently or within the past forty-eight (48) hours have experienced any symptoms associated with COVID-19, which include among other things:

- Fever or chills;
- Cough, shortness of breath, or difficulty breathing;
- Unusual fatigue;
- Muscle or body aches;
- Headache;
- Loss of taste or smell;
- Sore or scratchy throat;
- Nausea or vomiting, or;
- Diarrhea.

2. Had a positive test for COVID-19 in the last ten (10) days (or longer if still experiencing symptoms).

3. Is isolating or quarantining (or should be) because of a positive test or are worried that he or she may be sick with COVID-19.

4. Been in close contact within the last ten (10) days with someone who has tested positive or had any of the above-referenced COVID-19 symptoms.

Assumption of risk: by signing below, you confirm that you have read and understand the above warnings concerning COVID-19, and hereby choose to accept the risk of contracting COVID-19 for yourself and/or your loved one who participates as a member in order to utilize Sunny Day Club's services and enter BPC Sunny Day Club's premises. These services are of such value to you and/or to your loved one, that you and your loved one accept the risk of being exposed to, contracting, and/or spreading COVID-19 in order to utilize the club's services and church premises in person.

YOU HAVE CAREFULLY READ AND FULLY UNDERSTAND ALL PROVISIONS OF THIS ACKNOWLEDGEMENT, AND FREELY AND KNOWINGLY ASSUME THE RISKS OF PARTICIPATING IN CLUB ACTIVITIES:
